On behalf of the Federal Asian Pacific American Council (FAPAC), we would like to invite your organization to support and participate in our 33<sup>rd</sup> Annual National Leadership Training Program (NLTP) to be held on May 14-17, 2018, at the Sheraton Pentagon City in Arlington, VA. The theme for this year is "Unite Our Vision by Working Together". The NLTP coincides with the observance of Asian Pacific Islander Heritage Month each year. It is the largest training event of its kind. Through your participation and sponsorship, the NLTP is an opportunity to reach out to Asian American and Pacific Islanders (AAPI) as well as all federal employees throughout the Federal government.

The National Leadership Training Program is expected to draw 200-300 attendees across the federal and DC governments to learn from the experiences of senior government officials and workshops on career development, leadership, strategic management, communications and diversity. We will also host free programs for veterans and students that include access to exhibitors.

The NLTP has been approved by the Office of Personnel Management (OPM) every year as an appropriate training for federal workforce. In addition to the plenary sessions, the NLTP is a great opportunity for professional and personal development through the many workshops in communications, career development, leadership, and diversity in the workplace presented by experienced and dynamic trainers. There are workshops for young professionals and healthcare issues relating to AAPI. Over 50 agencies will have exhibits with information on their career programs and job opportunities for students and veterans. Exhibits will be open from Tuesday May 15 through Thursday May 17. FAPAC continue to provide its Executive Career Coaching to attendees; participant can meet one-on-one and face-to-face with an executive coach for consultation and career advice.

FAPAC recognizes civilian and military employees and partnered with the Department of Defense (DOD) and other agencies on the recognition and honoring of our military, and civilian employees; these recognitions and awards are presented during the award luncheons and evening banquet as part of the program. In addition, FAPAC will be presenting a scholarship award, funded entirely from the proceeds of support to the NLTP. The Scholarship winner is chosen from submissions of students from across the country and is presented to the worthy recipient who plans a career in public service.

FAPAC, founded in 1985, is a nonprofit organization representing the civilian and military Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders (AAPI) of all ranks in the Federal and District of Columbia governments. We promote equal opportunity, cultural diversity, participation, and advancement of employees in the Government workforce through education, mentoring and development.
